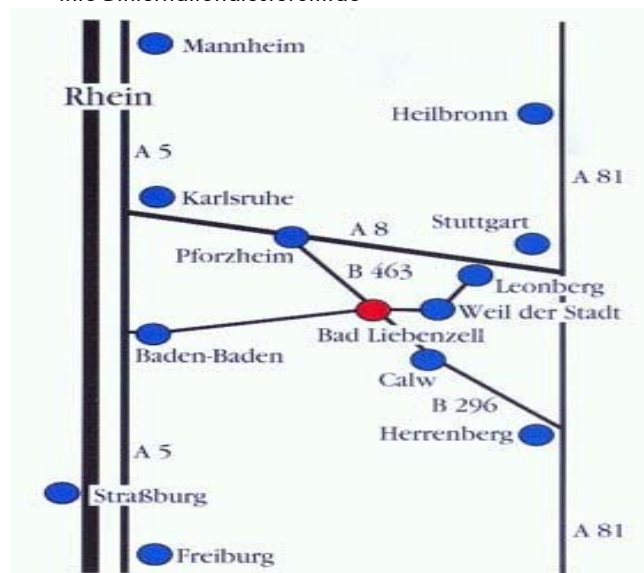

The EU and Ukraine: From the Association Agenda to the Danube Area Strategy

Since Ukraine's independence, the relations between the EU and Ukraine have been directed at closer cooperation and coordination in all fields – from economic to political, cultural and educational cooperation. Nevertheless, the country has not been given a clear perspective with view to future EU membership. Instead, a new Association Agenda was agreed which aims at the stimulation of further intensified cooperation and the stabilisation of the democratic process. Also, Ukraine became member state of the new EU macro strategy for the Danube Region. In all these approaches, education has a major role to play and is a crucial element for the sustainability of the association process. As a contribution to this objective, the seminar will provide insights into the functioning of the EU system in general but will also look at further opportunities for closer educational cooperation in the context of the Danube Region Strategy.
